Denver Health and all of its programs are useable by disabled persons. They are useable for persons who are deaf and hard of hearing. Also, for blind persons or who have other sensory needs.

Accessibility can be: easy off-street parking for disabled persons, curb cuts and ramps between parking and buildings, level way into the first floor with elevator use to all other floors, fully useable offices, bathrooms, waiting rooms, cafeteria, and patient treatment rooms, like exam rooms and wards. Communication aids are free for persons who are deaf, hard of hearing, blind, or with some other sensory needs. There is no charge for these aids and other aids. Sign language translators for persons who are deaf or hard of hearing are free. A 24-hour telecommunication tool (TTY) can link the caller to all extensions and portable (TTY) units, readers, and taped items for the blind and large print items for the visually impaired. Assistive tools for persons who need help with any skills are free. If you need any aids or other help, please tell the receptionist, your nurse, or your care provider.
